WELFARE

We are sure you have probably seen some concerning reports recently about how some gymnasts have been treated at some British Gymnastics Clubs. We would like to assure our members that none of the practices reported in the Whyte Review have ever taken place at NELGC.

NELGC subscribes to the principles of safeguarding and protecting children and vulnerable adults and aims to ensure that anyone participating at our gymnastics club is able to do so in a safe and child friendly environment. NELGC recognises its legal obligations under, and will abide by, the requirements of the BG Safeguarding and Protecting Children Policy.

Every member of staff and volunteer working for NELGC has a responsibility to safeguard children. At NELGC we promote a child-centred approach to the safeguarding and welfare of all our members. All of our coaches are fully qualified, have current British Gymnastics Membership (which includes insurance) and hold a current Enhanced DBS. They also have a recognised Safeguarding Award and all Level 2 coaches hold a Positive Coaching Award.

At the club our Club Welfare Officer is Tracy Hill. She is a member of British Gymnastics and holds a current Enhanced DBS. In addition to this she has attended Mental Health Training, Safeguarding & Protecting Children Course and Time to Listen Courses along with regular updates to enable her to be effective in their role. Our CWO maintains a strong relationship with our London Region Welfare Officer who can be called on to offer advice and support.

We are always seeking to expand our welfare provision, so if you would like to be part of the team in any capacity, we would love to hear from you.

Reintroducing Viewing at the Club

We have been unable to allow parents into the club to view sessions over the last few years starting from the beginning of the Coronavirus Pandemic. Due to the nature of the building and the limited amount of space that we have, we have tried to design the club so the majority of the space is for the gymnasts to practise and develop their skills. We have provided opportunities to view sessions and have recently 'Zoomed' the grading and group displays.





Whilst it would be fantastic to have a large viewing area, we also have many other issues to consider ie: gymnasts having access to the toilets, implications on clearing the building if there is a fire alarm, parents having access to toilets, staff having an area to leave their belongings safely etc. This all needs to be taken into consideration when designating and maintaining a viewing area. We are working hard to solve these issues and hope we will be able to have viewing opportunities in the near future.
